

A Community Healthcare Network – More than the Sum of its Parts

How do we Measure We Prevent

There are many parts to the Community Healthcare Network that work synergistically, resulting in services that keep people well at home and help to get them home when they have needed hospital care.

These services are **delivered day in and day out** across the CHN, and it is difficult to measure the impact on hospital avoidance.

The **CHNs** will be instrumental in developing a mechanism for measurement of impact of ECC on **Urgent & Emergency Care**





UHL ED attendance data reflects: 26,739 YTD this is a **5%** reduction (1,309 cases) on 2022.

UHL ED Attendances 75+ Years Old reflects: 3,888 YTD this is a 3% reduction (102 cases) on 2022

Can this be attributed to ECC?

CHNs across the MWCH have had over 300 complex case discussions in 2023, all of whom have an MDT care plan in place with 170 people on an At Risk of Unscheduled Care Register monitored by the Primary Care Team.
